This picture shows noise intermediate between Hoffmann's and Richards' locations. Hoise may be noted on the background. Several frames were required to expose the film so noise is somewhat integrated out. Here again the true character of the noise is not well presented by the photograph. Conditions such as vertical linearity were not considered in arranging for this photograph.

Exposure time of a few frames was used to give a true indication of noise. Observers of this picture insist that the photograph does not do the televised picture justice.
